**Speaker Before & After Dinner: (2 hrs A&A CPE):**

Bill Godshall is a partner with Frazier & Deeter and he will speak on the topics of (1) **PCAOB – Past, Present and Future** and (2) **The New Audit Risk Standards – One Year Later**. Bill joined the firm in 2005, after leaving the Public Company Accounting and Oversight Board (PCAOB) where he served as Inspection Leader.

He started his career with a Big Six firm in 1990, where he worked until 2002, when he left to join the Capital Markets Risk and Accounting Advisory group at a Big Four firm. While in this group, Bill specialized in assisting his clients with complex accounting and reporting issues, primarily in the energy and manufacturing industries.

Bill joined the PCAOB in January 2004, prior to the start of the first full-scope inspections of registered public accounting firms. At the PCAOB, he helped to develop the training program for full-scope inspections and the inspection methodology for audits of internal control over financial reporting. He also wrote the inspection guidance for derivative accounting and auditing areas that is in place today. Bill has led and participated in the inspections of several local firms throughout the Southeast. Welcome Bill Godshall !
