Day 1 - August 18 - Small electronics will be accepted at the Recycletronics™ booth in the Exhibit Hall.

Day 2 - August 19 - Large and small electronics will be accepted at the Rotunda Entrance from 7-9 a.m.

*TVs and computer monitors with Cathode Ray Tubes (CRTs) require a fee of \$10 for the first unit and \$5 for each additional unit. Other items will be recycled at no charge.

Almost anything with an electrical cord can be recycled EXCEPT:

refrigerators
washers
dryers
freezers
humidifiers

de-humidifiers
power equipment
household trash
non-electronic equipment
