The Georgia Society of CPAs is working to enact the Mobility for our CPA profession through SB 473. Mobility as a concept includes states having open borders for temporary engagements and promotes firms being able to mobilize their resources to get the right CPA to the client on an as needed basis without obtaining temporary permits or advance notice to cross state borders.

Thirteen states currently have enacted Mobility and eighteen states have legislation pending, including Georgia. Many more states will proceed in the 2009 legislative sessions.

The concept of Mobility and accompanying regulatory changes that are needed have been approved by the GSCPA Board of Directors, the GSCPA Council, and the Georgia State Board of Accountancy.

SB 473 secures the right of the Georgia State Board of Accountancy to discipline any CPA that works within their borders. Those that are enabled to cross borders to perform engagements must be from states judged substantially equivalent in regulatory requirements; this requires Georgia to update some regulatory requirements to the standards that are included in the Uniform Accountancy Act (UAA).

I urge you to support of Senate Bill 473.
