



VOLUNTEERING WITH JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT OF GEORGIA JA FINANCIAL LITERACY IN A DAY

Junior Achievement (JA) inspires and prepares young people to succeed in a global economy. JA brings the real world to students, opening their mind to their potential by bridging the business and education communities.

The Georgia Society of CPAs is entering its second year of supporting JA of Georgia's financial literacy programs through classroom volunteerism. Through this partnership, GSCPA volunteer role models prepare students to become financially literate through such topics as careers, budgeting, saving, and credit.

What we need:

Volunteers to teach at **Chamblee Middle School** for the JA in a Day program on **Tuesday, January 22, 2008**. You will arrive around 8:00 am and finish by about 1:00 pm.

How it works:

JA provides you with a kit that holds all lesson plans and hands-on materials. JA matches you with a middle school class, and JA trains you on the materials and working with students. You make an impact on lives through teaching students about personal finance. You introduce the Georgia Society of CPAs to students, and you introduce yourself as a role model.

How much time this requires:

Training	1.5 hours (see below for training date options)
6 Class Prep Times	45 minutes per class (at home-may vary depending on your preparation style)*
Day of the Event	5 hours (approximately)
Total Volunteer Time	11 hours (approximately)

*JA and GSCPA are working to recruit enough volunteers to secure two volunteers per classroom so that you can divide prep time in half. The opportunity to partner, thereby splitting the prep time, will be contingent on securing enough volunteers.
